About us:

About the role:

- Look to exploit new avenues for recruitment including candidates from traineeships,
 BAME and ex-military
- Help to improve and drive equality & diversity within the sector reaching out to new communities
- Manage the process of recruitment for members to the point of apprentice enrolment
- Use multiple platforms to proactively engage with potential apprentices, adopting a creative approach to maximise our exposure and candidate attraction across all platforms, hosting in-house events, college open days, registering for and attending external events
