

## **Technical Lead – Hazardous Waste**

# **Role and Responsibilities**

We are seeking an experienced **Technical Lead – Hazardous Waste** with especial experience in the Asbestos Removal industry (Licensed and Non-Licensed) to work within our Asbestos Control and Abatement Department (ACAD).

Working alongside the Membership Officer you will manage the ACAD membership, carrying out a number of membership site audits, managing non-conformance issues and the development of corrective and preventative actions.

You will have excellent communication and engagement skills for day-to-day working at all levels; including weekly liaison with senior staff; technical discussions with the HSE, ACAD members and staff and members of the public. You will be experienced at working within or leading a team and will be able to adapt to situations and variations in workload; being flexible and versatile whilst maintaining efficiency. You will be expected to share the outcomes of your work internally, driving knowledge improvement within the ACAD team, and with the wider ACAD membership community through reports and presentations.

You will also be experienced and disciplined in working independently, have excellent organisational skills and preparedness for planning, scheduling and undertaking site visits, to maximise time and productivity, whilst ensuring delivery to time, cost and quality.

Experience directly within the asbestos sector is desirable however, applicants who have risk assessment experience and qualifications in other specialisms such as fire, water or general risk assessment are welcome to apply.

The role will be predominantly home based with some travel/field-based activities required.

#### **Duties:**

- Provide technical advice, guidance and assistance to ACAD members and prospective members.
- Liaise with and be the main point of contact between the HSE and ACAD, keeping up to date with all policy and legislative changes and ensuring these are effectively communicated to members.
- Deliver online and face to face training in a full range of Asbestos related courses and refresher courses.
- Liaise regularly with external sub-contractors, who undertake training and site audits on behalf of ACAD to ensure a high-quality service is being provided.
- Arrange and facilitate standardisation meetings for internal and external staff for audits and training.
- Support the Head of Learning to ensure training materials and resources are kept up to date in line with HSE guidance.



- Work alongside our Technical Director ensuring that our members are provided with the latest HSE information, providing technical advice, continuing to build and maintain excellent working relationships and overseeing member audits.
- Attend regional and national meetings, site audits and some face-to-face training events across the UK
- Attend external industry technical meetings and conferences.

## **Experience and Qualifications:**

- Minimum of 5 years relevant experience, preferably working within the hazardous waste sector.
- A degree or equivalent in a relevant science discipline.
- A teaching and/or assessing qualification at Level 3 or above (desirable\*)
- Relevant industry competence qualification(s) i.e. BOHS P402 (or equivalent) and BOHS P403 and P404 (or equivalent) or S301 (W504) with CoCA
- Excellent working knowledge of asbestos surveying and regulations
- Proven technical understanding and practical application of asbestos compliance regulations and guidance
- Excellent report writing, IT and communication skills both written and oral
- Full driving licence
